JOB PLACEMENTS:

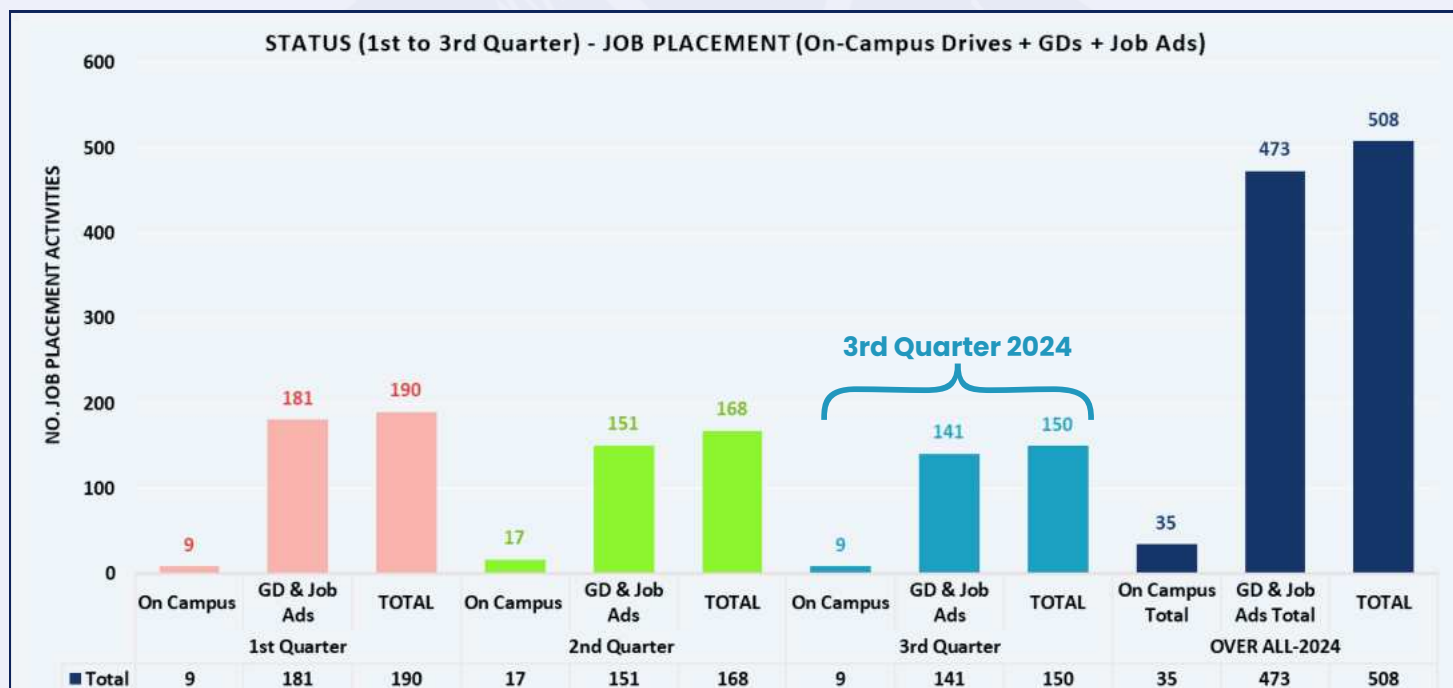

03 SCENARIOS:

Students may be allowed to take-up co-op at particular industry during Summer/Ramadan and Winter/Semester Break/ vacations returning back to studies during regular FALL and SPRING semesters. The cycle may be repeated subject to satisfactory performance of the student (1st to last semester)

2

Students may be allowed to take-up a part-time co-op (after University hours) at the partner industry during regular FALL and SPRING semesters and full-time co-op during vacations. The cycle may be repeated subject to satisfactory performance of the student.

Participating co-op employers may assign well-defined tasks to students to complete in a year that may be counted towards final year project of the students

Following steps need to be taken in order to implement Co-op education in NED University system.

A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) may be signed among University and the co-op employer on the mutually agreed terms and conditions.

FEEDBACK

Get feedback on the co-op from students as well as employers, arrange certificate distribution ceremony, DO IT AGAIN (Repeat Cycle).
